

DECORATING CHEAT SHEET

DINING TABLE CHANDELIERS

How big should a chandelier be that hangs above a dining table? Follow this guide to work out the rightsize chandelier for your dining table.

In general you want your chandelier to be three-quarters of the width of your dining table. So width x 0.75 = diameter

CALCULATE THE CORRECT SIZE

(A) Measure the width of your dining table

(B) Subtract 30cm or multiply by 0.75

(C) The result is the desirable diameter of your chandelier

(A)100cm - (B) 30cm = (C)
70cm
